## Baby Bulky Rolled Edge Hat Pattern Designed by Christina Knight

Hats are easy to work in the round. This hat is great for a last minute gift or a quick and satisfying project for you! Enjoy building your skills with circular and double-pointed needles! For those of you who know the magic loop method, you can do these hats and any hats using one 40" circular needle!

- Materials:** Approx. 65 yds of a bulky weight yarn.  
Size #10 16" circular *and* dpn needles or size to achieve gauge  
Tapestry needle
- Gauge:** 3 - 3.5 stitches to 1 inch
- Size:** Average baby head circumference is 14 inches
- Stitches used:** k = knit, k2tog = knit two stitches together

### Instructions:

Cast on 48 stitches

Join in the round and place marker to indicate the beginning of each round.

Knit even for 3-4 inches.

Switch to double pointed needles by evenly distributing 48 stitches onto 3 needles. (slip 16 stitches on each needle). Use the fourth needle as you continue working in the round).

### Begin crown shaping with decrease stitches:

Round 1: k6, k2tog, k6, k2tog – repeat for entire round

Round 2: k5, k2tog, k5, k2tog – repeat

Round 3: k4, k2tog, k4, k2tog – repeat

Round 4: k3, k2tog, k3, k2tog – repeat

Round 5: k2, k2tog, k2, k2tog – repeat

Round 6: k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog – repeat

Round 7: k2tog for entire round

Take tapestry needle and weave in through remaining stitches and pull together to finish hat. Weave in tails.
